Day in the Bank Policy

The Local 13 Apprentice Training Program allows apprentices to collect Days in the Bank which can be used as make-ups for missed classes. If you know you are going to miss a night of school, be sure to sign up for one of these events.

Participation in the following events will give an apprentice a day in the bank:

- **The Labor Day Parade:** To get this day the Apprentice must join the Local 13 group and walk the entire parade route.
- **Literature drops for Voters:** To get this day Apprentices must sign up with the Union Office and spend a Saturday morning distributing campaign literature as directed.
- **Red Cross Blood Drive:** To get this day in the bank the Apprentice must sign up ahead of time and if the drive is on their school night they should set an early appointment, before school starts. We do 3 blood drives per year.
- **Instructor Work Days:** Prior to the start of the school year we will have a couple of work days where Instructors can come in to organize or set up classrooms. To get this day the Apprentice must arrive at the appointed time and help out as directed by an Instructor.
- **Picnic / Clambake:** Occasionally Apprentices are asked to work at these events, and will receive a day in the bank for working.

Apprentices must sign the attendance sheet for the event to get credit.

Apprentices are not allowed to accrue more than 3 days in the bank. Banked days only apply to the current school year and do not carry over from year to year.
